SOUTH AFRICAN NATIONAL DEFENCE FORCE AND SOUTH
AFRICAN COMBAT RIFLE CHAMPIONSHIPS: 20 TO 27 SEPTEMBER
2014 : BLOEMFONTEIN

1. The South African National Defence Force(SANDF) and the South African Combat Rifle Association(SACRA) championships will take place from 20 to 27 September 2014 at Gen. De Wet shooting range, Bloemfontein.
2. The SANDF Championship will take place on Saturday 20 September 2014. Details and match conditions are not finalized yet and will be pronounced later.
Entry fee : R 200.00.
3. The SACRA Championship entry fee is R1000.00 including the prize giving function on Friday evening 26 September 2014. The team entries is R 400.00 for all Unit and Mix team matches.
4. The team matches will start on 22 September 2014 and the individual matches will start on the 23 September 2014 after the official opening.
5. On Saturday 27 September 2014 the South African National team matches will take place between South Africa, Lesotho , Botswana, New Zealand, US National Guards and British Reserve Forces. Thereafter all Provincial teams will participate against each other.
6. Shooters will be classified according to SACRA rules and regulations. See www.sacra.org.za for more information.
7. Only ammunition issued on the range is to be used. International shooters may use the ammunition as prescribed for their rifles.
8. The prize giving will take place on Friday evening 26 September 2014 at 18h00 for 18h30 and the cost for guests/spouses/non-shooters is R 130.00 per person.
9. The Range officer for both competitions will be WO1 F Lategan.
